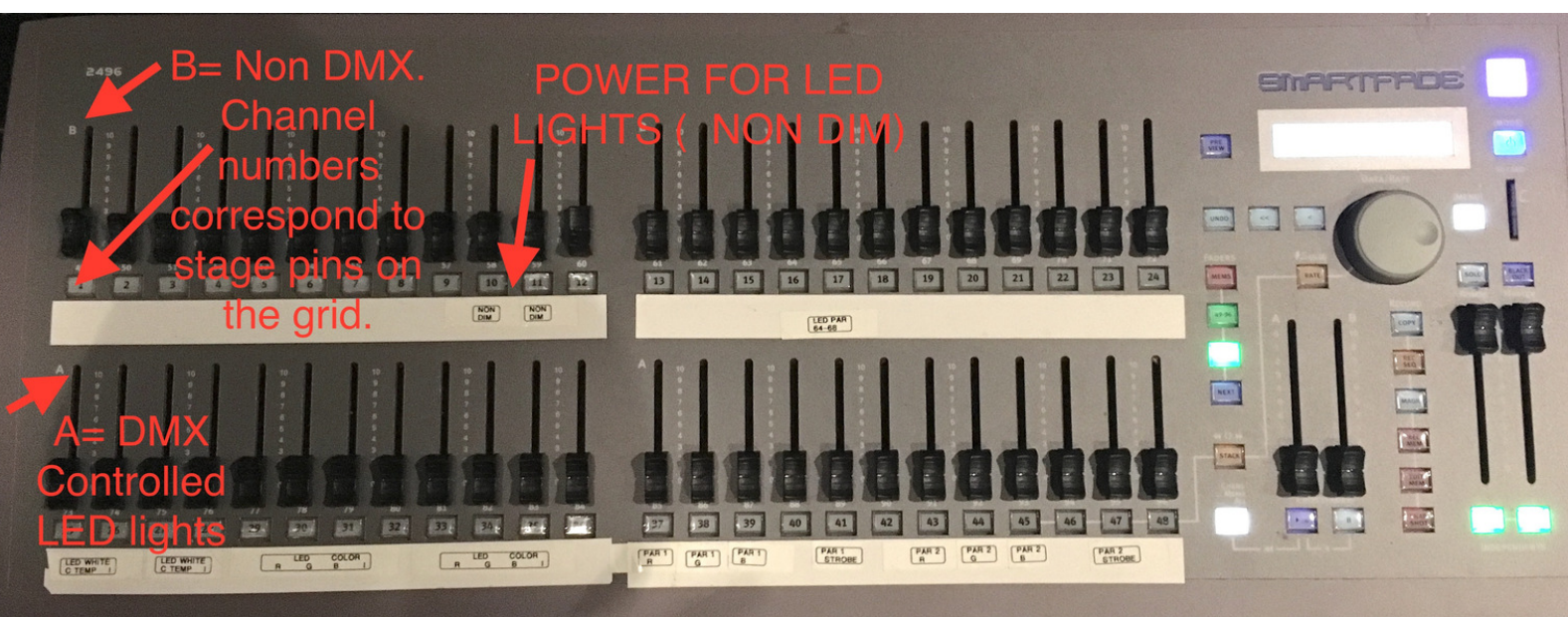

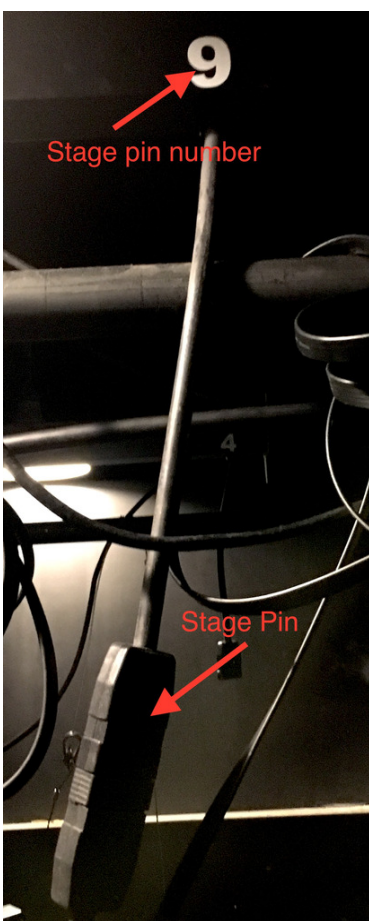
ETC LIGHT BOARD

The **ETC Smart Fade** lighting control console (also called a light board, lighting board, or lighting desk) is an electronic device used to control the lights and power on the grid in the black box. The ETC console communicates with the dimmers and other devices in the lighting system via an electronic protocol called DMX. The ETC board has 96 channels. Channels 1-24 are used for the grid stage pins

The **DMX** cable connects to the DMX port and the ETC board.



LIGHT GRID



The **stage pins** on the grid are a standard 3 pin connector that connects power to the light.

The Stage pin number corresponds to the number on the ETC light board.



NOTES: POWERING DMX LIGHTS AND VIDEO PROJECTORS REQUIRE THAT THE ETC LIGHT BOARD CHANNEL AND MASTER FADER BE SET TO FULL AT ALL TIMES
