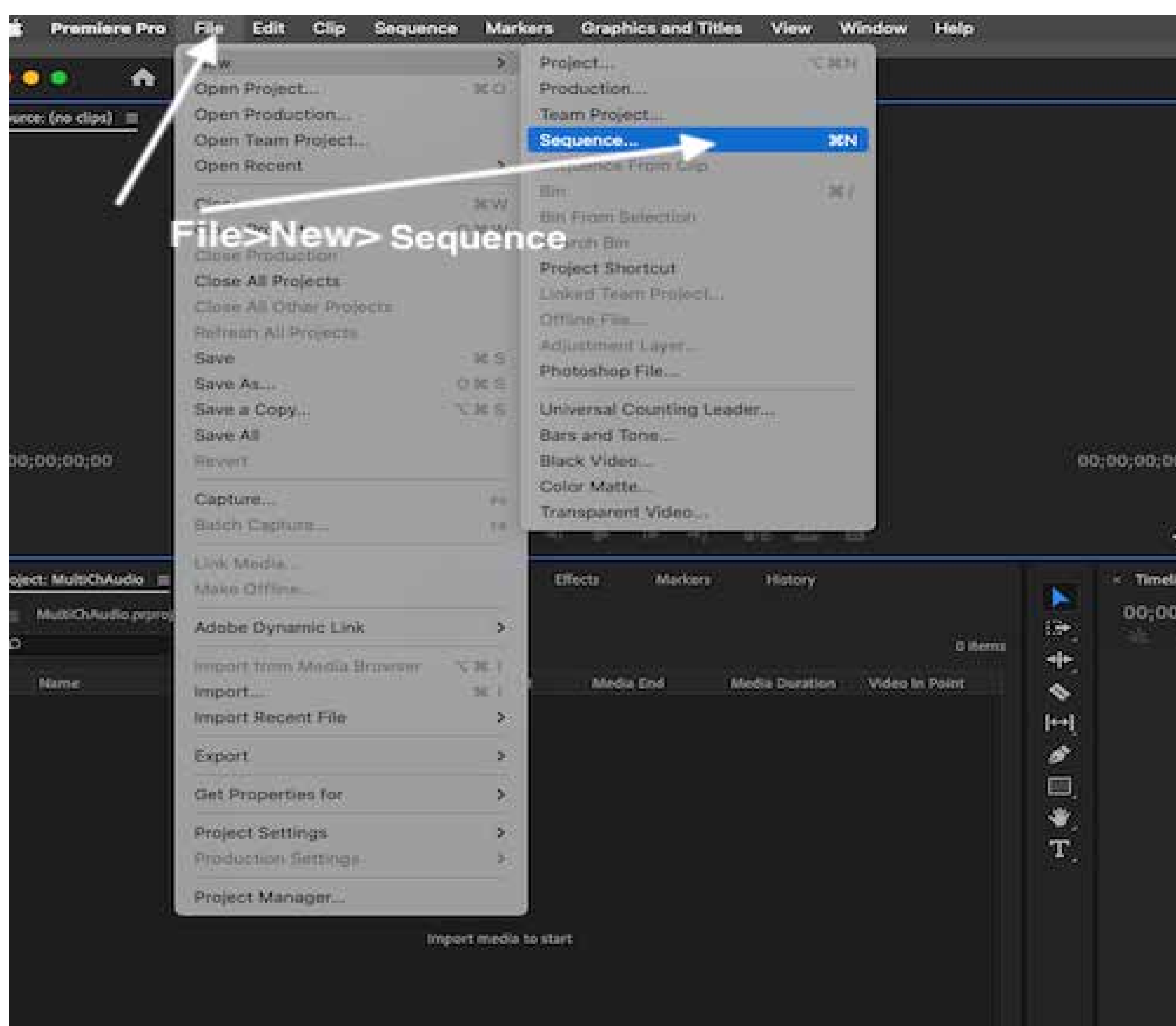


Premiere Multi Channel Audio Set-up Guide

To set-up your Premiere multi-channel audio Sequence please follow the steps below.

1 Create a Premiere project then a new sequence.



2 Change Sequence Settings

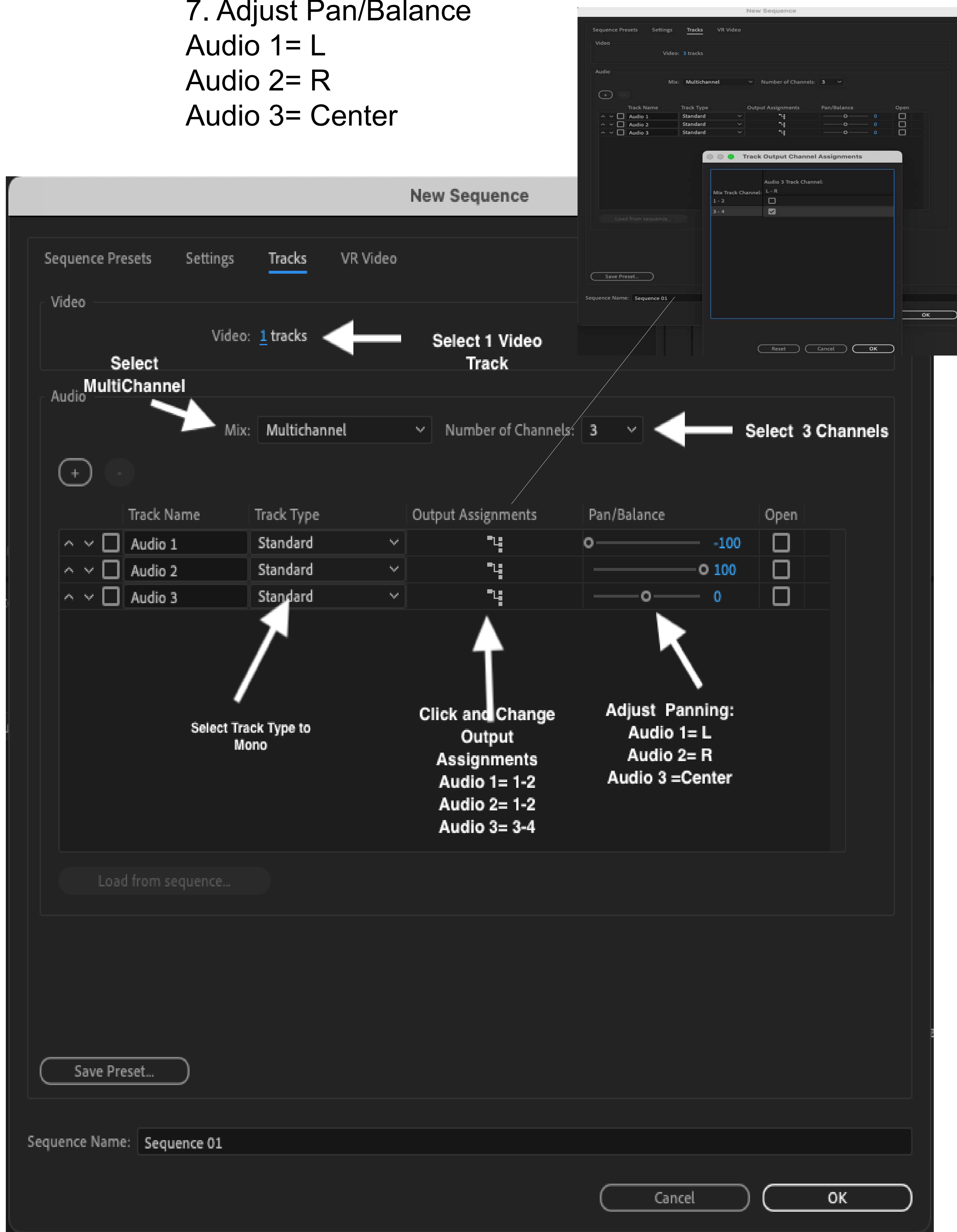
Setting Tab

Change Frame Size - 4080X768

*Timebase should equal your footage frame rate

Tracks Tab

1. Video tracks =1
 2. Mix= Multichannel
 3. Number of Channels=3
 4. Track Type= Mono
 5. Click and Change output assignments
- Audio 1=1-2
Audio 2= 1-2
Audio = 3-4
6. Change Track Type to Mono
 7. Adjust Pan/Balance
- Audio 1= L
Audio 2= R
Audio 3= Center



When the sequence is set-up properly you should see Three separate audio channels on the audio meters.
